Colonel Geoff Catlett enlisted in the Army in 1989 as an 11C Infantry Mortarman. He was commissioned as an Armor Second Lieutenant in the United States Army in 1992 from the US Army Officer Candidate School at Fort Benning, GA. He has served in numerous leadership, command and staff positions including tank platoon leader, mortar platoon leader, support platoon leader, recruiting company commander, cavalry troop and headquarters troop commander, division planner, squadron executive officer, squadron and brigade operations officer, armor battalion commander, infantry battalion commander, and division deputy chief of staff.
